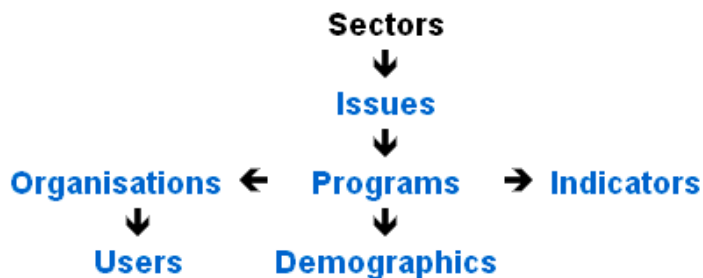


# EXPLANATION OF THE SECTORS, ISSUES, PROGRAMS AND DEMOGRAPHICS TOPICS

## **Social Indicators**
